### FOR THE MARYLAND GENERAL ASSEMBLY SESSION OF 2010

#### OPENNESS IN GOVERNMENT

- We support full public disclosure of House and Senate committee votes published on the Maryland General Assembly website: [mlis.state.md.us](http://mlis.state.md.us) including dates and legislator votes.
- We support the elimination of fees for *Up-To-The-Minute* and the availability of this information to all Marylanders.
- We support the pod- or broadcasting of the Board of Public Works meetings and work sessions.

#### ADEQUATE STATE REVENUE

- We support a revenue structure for Maryland which is equitable, reliable, adequate and progressive over all. We must protect the most vulnerable residents through a safety net of basic social services.

#### HEALTH CARE

##### UNIVERSAL ACCESS TO QUALITY CARE

- We support legislation that will make a basic level of quality health care accessible to all residents that is available at an affordable cost.
- We support reproductive choice.

#### ENVIRONMENT

##### LAND USE

- We support managed land use and growth management through the principles of smart growth, which promote public transportation, protect the natural environment and provide for better water and air quality.

##### CLIMATE CHANGE
